Saints of the Week



September 27th,
St. Vincent De Paul,
Priest

Today we recall the magnificent life of the Saint of Charity, the totally dedicated little “Monsieur Vincent” (1581-1660). A parish priest near Paris, he developed the apostolate of fighting all physical and moral evils of his time. The galley slaves, abandoned babies, prostitutes, victims of war, de-Christianized poor – all came under his mantle of generous care. With St. Louise de Marillac he founded the Daughters of Charity. To develop Christ-like priests he founded the Congregation of the Missions (called Vincentians). He died on this date in 1660 and was canonized a saint in 1737. The patron of all charitable societies, Vincent de Paul’s life and ideal of charity still inspire the Church.

Scripture contains many references to angels. Special biblical attention is paid to Michael (Protector of the People of God), Gabriel (Messenger of the Annunciation to Mary) and Raphael (the Healer in the Book of Tobit).
