Saints of the Week



September 13th,
St. John Chrysostom,
Bishop

Born at Antioch around 349, today's saint received an excellent education, led an ascetical life, as a priest preached effectively. Elected Bishop and Patriarch of Constantinople in 397, John "of the Golden Tongue" was a thorough, dedicated pastor of his flock. From hatred of the imperial court and enemies he was twice exiled. In present day Turkey, on the road to exile again, he died of consumption on September 14, 407.
