Sigmaringen,
Priest & Martyr

This martyr is a witness to the tragic times of the Reformation, when Christians killed other Christians in the name of Christ. Born in Sigmaringen, Germany, in 1578, Fidelis became a Capuchin. As superior of different monasteries Fidelis showed himself charitable and zealous. Sent by the Propagation of the Faith to preach to Protestants, Fidelis was killed in 1622 by Swiss fanatics. He was canonized a saint in 1746.

St. Mark,
Evangelist

Mark, or John Mark, was intimately associated with the development of the young Church. Born in Jerusalem, he accompanied Barnabas, Paul and Peter in the apostolic labors. Mark was a helper to the stronger personalities. His Gospel seems to reflect peter's preaching. But the direct, concrete, colorful style expresses Mark himself. Considered founder of the Church of Alexandria in Egypt, Mark is specially honored by the Coptic Christians of that country.
