St. Augustine,
Bishop and Doctor

The brilliant mind of Augustine continues to influence the Church. Born (354) in Africa, Augustine led a life of unsettled faith and morality until 387. Then in Milan he was baptized by St. Ambrose. Returning to Africa, Augustine led an ascetic life. Elected Bishop of Hippo, for 34 years he was a totally dedicated pastor. By sermons and writings he fought errors, explained the faith, laid the foundations for much of Catholic social teaching and theology. Augustine died in 430 as the barbarians besieged Hippo and the Roman world was collapsing. Every educated Catholic should know Augustine's Confessions.
