August 7th,
St. Sixtus II, Pope and
Martyr and
Companions

We commemorate the most shocking and most glorious page in the history of the Roman persecutions. On August 6, 258, the Pope was saying Mass at the Catacombs of St. Callistus. He and his four deacons were arrested and decapitated before the people. Three other deacons were similarly decapitated in that cruel attack, launched by the Emperor Valerian against bishops, priest and deacons.

The "little plant of St. Francis," Clare Offreduccio, was born in Assisi. On Palm Sunday of 1212 this 18 year old young woman escaped from her wealthy home and received the religious habit from St. Francis. Clare became the mother and Foundress of the Franciscan Second Order, called the "Poor Clares." After a life of remarkable discipline, holiness and poverty, she died in 1253.
