February 5<sup>th</sup>,  
St. Agatha,  
Virgin and Martyr

The name Agatha in the Greek language means "good." Agatha's martyrdom can be set in 251, during the persecution of Decius, at Catania in Sicily. There were many who apostatized, especially officials. But some young people, women and men, demonstrated the strength of their faith. Among them Agatha was outstanding. The people of Catania often invoked Agatha-especially when Mount Etna was erupting. Agatha is listed in the First Eucharistic Prayer.



February 8<sup>th</sup>,  
St. Jerome Emiliani,

Today's saint, born in 1486, was a typical Venetian soldier. When 25 he was captured and imprisoned-and in prison was converted to Christ and to serving the poor of society. In times of pestilence he was heroic in caring for the orphans. Jerome started a religious order, died of the plague in 1537 and was canonized a saint in 1767.
