January 7th,
St. Raymond of Penyafort,
Priest

Born at Penyafort near Barcelona (Spain) in 1175, Raymond became a priest and professor of philosophy and Canon Law. Joining the Dominicans in 1222, he was one of the most famous Masters of Moral Theology and Canon Law, specializing in the Sacrament of Penance. He was also a courageous apostolic man. A co-founder of the Order for the Redemption of Captives (to return Christian prisoners of the Mohammedans), Raymond studied Arabic and the Koran so as to dialogue with Mohammedans. He died, almost a centenarian, on January 6, 1275, and was declared a saint in 1601.



January 7th,
St. Hilary,
Bishop and Doctor

Hilary was born towards the start of the 4th Century, at Poitiers in France. Married and father of a saintly daughter named Abia, Hilary was converted to the Christian faith by reading the Scriptures, especially the Prologue to the Fourth Gospel. As Bishop of Poitiers he fought against the Arians, suffered exile, wrote extensively and helped his people. He died in 367.
