July 30th,
St. Peter Chrysologus,
Bishop

Called Chrysologus (“golden worded”) because of his eloquence, today’s saint was born near Ravenna in Italy around 480. Elected bishop of Ravenna when that Kingdom was at its strongest, Peter I was an effective, dedicated pastoral leader. He preached briefly and preached much. Some 180 of his sermons still exist. They show him to have been a direct, warm, convincing speaker. Bishop Peter I died on a July 30th, between 451 and 458.

St. Eusebius of Vercelli,
Bishop

Today’s saint was born in Sardinia around 300. Eusebius became a priest of Rome-and in 345 first bishop of Vercelli in north Italy. He opposed the Arians and around 355 was exiled by the Emperor. Returning in 361, Eusebius again developed the faith, encouraged priests to live a community life and died in holiness on August 1, 371.
