Saints of the Week



June 21st,
St. Aloysius Gonzaga,
Religious

The son of a high dignitary of the Spanish court, Aloysius at age 16 gave up his hereditary right to be prince of Mantua in Italy. Called to a life of prayer and purity, he was attracted to the Jesuits. Their discipline made him advance remarkably in sanctity. Becoming ill from contagion while helping the sick, Aloysius died at age 23. Canonized a saint in 1726, he was proclaimed "Patron of Youth" by Pope Benedict XIII.

English speaking Catholics show admiration and devotion to these martyrs, John Fisher was the lone bishop of England who refused to compromise belief in the Pope as Head on earth of the Lord's church. Thomas More was the devout layman and lawyer former chancellor of King Henry VIII, whose faith and conscience made him refuse to accept the King of England as Head on earth of the Church. Both exemplify the well-educated Christian humanist who combined learning, sense of humor and profound spirituality. Both were decapitated in the Tower of London.
