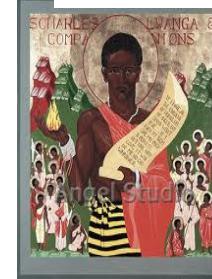

Saints of the Week



June 3rd,
St. Charles Lwanga &
Companions,
Martyrs

The universal Church today honors 22 black martyrs of Uganda in Africa. The first martyrs of black Africa, they died in a persecution similar to those of the ancient Roman Emperors. Most of them had been baptized but a short time. Charles Lwanga, chief of the royal pages, was killed with twelve companions on this date in 1886. The Uganda martyrs were canonized as saints by Pope Paul VI in 1964.



June 5th,
St. Boniface,
Bishop and Martyr

Boniface, Apostle to the Germans, was originally an Englishman named Wilfrid. He became a Benedictine monk and in 716 was sent by the Pope to evangelize the German tribes. Boniface traveled constantly, establishing dioceses and monasteries. His most beloved monastery was at Fulda. Boniface labored also to reorganize the Church in France, and was killed with 52 companions by pagan fanatics in 755. He is buried in Fulda.
