June 27th,
St. Cyril of Alexandria,
Bishop and Doctor

Cyril of Alexandria is connected with the Council of Ephesus (431) and the struggle against the Nestorian heresy. Nestorius refused to give to Mary the title Mother of God. Cyril, by then Bishop in his native city for 20 years, battled impetuously against Nestorianism and presided over the Council which declared Mary to be Mother of God. Cyril died in 444.



June 28th,
St. Irenaeus,
Bishop & Martyr

Irenaeus was born around 135 Smyrna in Asia Minor. He was a student under Polycarp, who in his time had been a student under the Apostle John. Irenaeus became a priest in Lyons, France, and later bishop of Lyons. He wrote theological expositions to defend the faith against Gnostic heresies, demonstrated a vigorous missionary spirit, and was martyred around 200.
