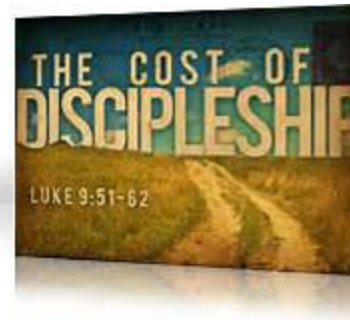

Apostle

Thomas is known among the apostles especially for his unbelief. That unbelief vanished before the risen Christ. Thomas gave us the exclamation of Easter faith: “My Lord and my God!” Apart from the Gospels, nothing certain is known of his life and ministry. The Christians of Malabar (west coast of India) honor Thomas as founder of their Church. The Church of Syria takes its liturgy from St. Thomas and since 232 has honored him on this date.



July 4th,
St. Elizabeth of Portugal

Princess of Aragon and grandniece of St. Elizabeth of Hungary, this Elizabeth (1271-1336) was married at age 12 to King Dionysius of Portugal. Her life was frequently upset by politics and family quarrels, but kept in balance by deep spirituality, prayer and charity. As a widow she renounced the world and lived in poverty and obscurity in the habit of a Third Order Franciscan. Elizabeth died while trying to settle further family quarrels. She was canonized a saint in 1626.
