John Cidade was born in Portugal

in 1495, shortly after Columbus discovered America. He led an adventuresome youth in Spain, and at age 44 was converted by a sermon. He dedicated himself totally to the care of the miserable, abandoned ones of society. A mysterious child gave him the name "John of God." His hospital work grew so much that he started the Order of Brothers Hospitallers of St. John of God. John died in 1550 and was canonized a saint in 1690.
