Saints of the Week



May 27th,
St. Augustine of
Canterbury,
Bishop

In 596 Pope Gregory the Great decided to send missionaries to the Saxons in England. The Pope assigned a group of Roman monks, of whom Augustine was superior. Augustine was more a follower than leader-but obedience produced excellent results in conversions. Augustine became the first Archbishop of Canterbury and organized the Roman Catholic Church in England. He died in 604 or 605.



June 1st,
St. Justin,
Martyr

Justin, a layman, exerted a strong influence in the early Church. He went through a difficult intellectual struggle to find Christ. Born in Samaria around 100 AD, he studied various philosophies and was converted to Christ when about 30 years old. Justin taught in Ephesus, later opened a school in Rome, and wrote defenses of Christianity. He wrote our oldest descriptions of the Baptismal rite and of Sunday mass. Justin died a heroic martyr's death in about 165, during the persecution of the philosopher Emperor, Marcus Aurelius.
