Sts. Simon and Jude,  
Apostle

Today we celebrate the feast of two  
Apostles. The name Simon is eleventh on the list of the  
Twelve. It is known that Simon came from Cana and was  
called “Zealot”- perhaps a member of the activist political  
party against Roman occupation of Judea. The apostle Jude,  
called Thaddaeus, spoke with Jesus during the Last Supper  
(Jn 14:22). In lists of the Apostles these two are always  
together.

St. Martin de Porres,  
Religious

Today's humble saint, son of a white  
Spanish grandee father and a black Panamanian  
mother, was born in Lima, Peru, in 1579. As a boy he  
learned the art of healing. Entering the Dominicans,  
he served as infirmarian and in 1603 took religious  
vows. Martin healed the illnesses of the poor and also  
of animals, led a life of profound prayer, penance, and  
extraordinary spiritual gifts and died in 1639. A patron  
saint of American blacks, he was canonized by Pope  
John XXIII in 1962.
