In the year 1679 this newly-
ordained priest began a new educational work. At
Rheims in France, his city of birth, John opened a
school to educate poor children. The education was
not classical, but rather practical and directed towards
living as a Christian worker. He opened other schools,
and in 1684 founded in religious community, the
Brothers of the Christian Schools. His last years were
filled with great trials. These he bore in Christ-like
silence. He died on today's date, Good Friday in 1619.
He was canonized a saint in 1900.

Lenten Reflections:

"In a profound way we are being called to care for one
another in a gospel-like way: to die to our own needs
and to love someone else more deeply -- our spouse,
our parents, our children. We are being called to take
care of others before we take care of ourselves. It's
counter cultural when everything in our lives and
world says "it's all about me. I'm an army of one.
Make sure I get what I need first." Yes, you have to put
on your own oxygen mask before you help others. But
in our closest relationships, we are invited to **cherish**
each other."
