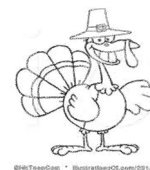

St. John Eudes,  
Priest

Today's saint, born in France  
(1601), had an outstanding education before  
ordination as an Oratorian priest. After many  
years of effective mission preaching, he  
concluded that the best way to bring Christ to the  
poor people was to form educated, zealous  
priests. So John Eudes, founded four seminaries,  
established the Congregation of Jesus and of  
Mary (the Eudists) to direct seminaries, started  
the Institute of Our Lady of Charity to care for  
wayward girls, and fostered the Sacred Heart  
devotion. He died in 1680.
