Virgin & Martyr

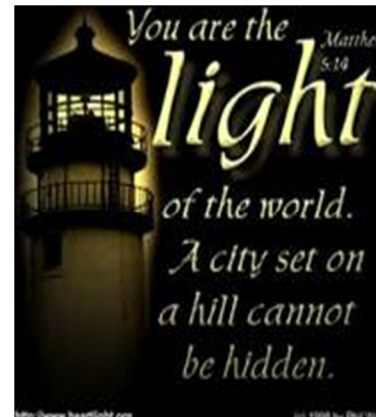
The name Agatha in the Greek language means “good.” Agatha’s martyrdom can be set in 251, during the persecution of Decius, at Catania in Sicily. There were many who apostatized, especially officials. But some young people, women and men, demonstrated the strength of their faith. Agatha was outstanding. The people of Catania often invoked Agatha-especially when Mt. Etna was erupting. Agatha is listed in the First Eucharistic Prayer.
