January 28th,
St. Thomas Aquinas,
Priest & Doctor

This great Dominican teacher lived only 49 years (1225-1274). But he traveled much: from his birthplace at Aquino in central Italy to Cologne, to Paris, to Rome and to the monastery near Naples where he died. He wrote much. His two Summas should not obscure his other biblical, theological and philosophical writings. Thomas prayed much-and dedicated his brilliant talents to investigating the sublime truth of God in the light of faith and the human intellect. On this date his body was transferred to the Dominican Monastery at Toulouse. Canonized in 1323, he is Patron of all Catholic Schools and is titled the “Angelic Doctor.”



February 3rd ,
St. Blasé,
Bishop & Martyr

St. Blasé was bishop of Sebaste-of Armenia in modern Turkey. It is known that he was tormented and killed during the persecution of Licinius (320-324). Among the stories about St. Blasé is that he cured a young man choking from a fishbone. The blessing of St. Blasé is invoked against throat ailments. It is appropriately given in winter, when colds and viruses are more frequent.
