Saints of the Week

July 31st, St. Ignatius of Loyola, Priest

Today's saint, founder of the Jesuits, has since the 16th Century had a profound influence on Catholic history. Born in the Basque area of Spain, at Loyola (1493), Ignatius after being wounded as a soldier found Christ. A strong and holy organizer, Ignatius founded the Society of Jesus along military lines at Paris in 1534. At a critical time the Jesuits were magnificent in resisting Protestantism, reforming the Church, laboring in mission lands and in the educational apostolate. His "Spiritual Exercises" helped many other to conversion. Ignatius, demonstrating manly love for Christ and unconditional loyalty to the Pope, died at Rome on July 31, 1556. He was canonized a saint in 1622.
