

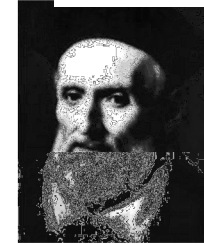

St. Romuald,
Abbot

Romuald, son of the Duke of Ravenna, was born in that illustrious city around the year 950. A follower of Benedict but called to the solitary hermit's life, he used to live as a hermit near Benedictine monasteries so as to join the monks in liturgical prayer. At Comaldi in the Appennine Mountains he founded the Order of the Hermit Camaldolese monks. A follower of his could live as a monk, or as a hermit with liturgical prayer with monks, or as a complete solitary. In 1027 Romuald died in solitude.

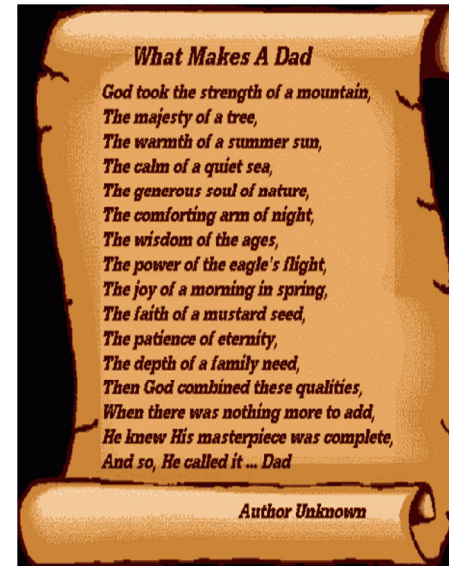
