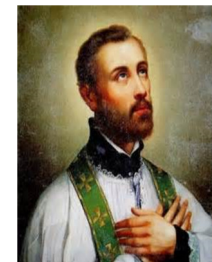
Parish News

This saint's story is one of heroic adventure. Born at Xavier (Navarre), Spain, in 1506, Francis was one of the first Jesuits. Though suffering from sciatica, he was ordered to preach the Gospel in the unknown Far East. For eleven years, in suffering and prayer, he brought the Gospel to India, Ceylon, and Japan. He died at the gates of China in 1522, at age 46, and was canonized a saint in 1662.
