Saints of the Week



September 16th,
St. Cornelius,
Pope & Martyr
And St. Cyprian,
Bishop & Martyr

Today we commemorate two friends in the service of Christ and the Church. Cyprian, Bishop of Carthage, went to death with courage publicly before his people. His martyrdom on Sept. 14, 258, was almost like a solemn liturgy and developed the faith of the Church of Carthage. To Cornelius he had written earlier, “If God gives one of us the grace to die soon, our friendship will continue before the Lord.” Cornelius, Pope for a short time (250-253), was exiled and killed for the faith at Civitavecchia in Italy.
