Saints of the Week



April 13th,
St. Martin I,
Pope & Martyr

Born in Italy and later a priest of Rome, in 649 Martin was elected Pope. His pontificate was tragic. He called a council to condemn a heresy. The Emperor in Constantinople reacted savagely. Constant II accused the Pope of political plotting, and had him arrested and brought to Constantinople. The Pope was publicly humiliated and exiled to the Crimea. There, after great sufferings, the last of the martyr Popes died at Sebastopol on this date in 656.
