Priest

Born in Aragona, Spain, in 1556, Joseph led the life of a rich young man for 36 years. Converted to Christ, he gave up all possessions to become a priest, zealous for the reform of the Church. Mysteriously attracted to Rome in 1592, he found there his true work-founding free schools for educating all classes. The schools and religious order flourished in Europe. Joseph's latter years were most difficult. He died piously in 1648, over 90 years of age and was canonized a saint in 1767.
