Saints of the Week



January 28th,
St. Thomas Aquinas,
Priest & Doctor

This great Dominican teacher lived only 49 years (1225-1274). But he traveled much: from his birthplace at Aquino in central Italy to Cologne, to Paris, to Rome and to the monastery near Naples where he died. He wrote much. His two Summas should not obscure his other biblical, theological and philosophical writings. Thomas prayed much-and dedicated his brilliant talents to investigating the sublime truth of God in the light of faith and the human intellect. On this date his body was transferred to the Dominican Monastery at Toulouse. Canonized in 123, he is Patron of all Catholic Schools and is titled the “Angelic Doctor.”
