Saints of the Week



January 7th,
St. Raymond of
Penyafort,
Priest

Born at Penyafort near Barcelona (Spain) in 1175, Raymond became a priest and professor of philosophy and Canon Law. Joining the Dominicans in 1222, he was one of the most famous Masters of Moral Theology and Canon Law, specializing in the Sacrament of Penance. He was also a courageous apostolic man. A co-founder of the Order for the Redemption of Captives (to return Christian prisoners of the Mohammedans), Raymond studied Arabic and the Koran so as to dialogue with Mohammedans. He died almost a centenarian on January 6, 1275, and was declared a saint in 1601.
