Thursday, July 16th – Knights of Columbus meeting at 7:30 pm in the Heritage Room. All members are asked to attend.

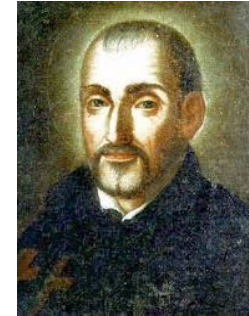


Turkey Festival

St. Camillus De Lellis,
Priest

Camillus, son of a soldier of the Kingdom of Naples, was 6'6" tall and exceptionally strong. He became a soldier, led a life without restraints-and at age 25 came with broken body to the Incurables Hospital in Rome. There Camillus was converted to Christ, in penance began serving the sick (though still incurable ill himself), gathered others to this work, and started the Company of Servants of the Sick. He became a priest and to the end of life, a sick giant among the sick, lived out the ideal of Christian charity. He was canonized a saint in 1746.

Our Lady of Mount
Carmel

The Bible praises the beauty of Mount Carmel, that promontory (in north Palestine overlooking the Mediterranean) where Elijah defended the purity of faith. Considered a sacred mountain, Carmel became the dwelling place to form the Order of Carmel, or Carmelites, dedicated to the Blessed Mother who had lived in contemplation nearby at Nazareth. The Carmelites promoted the life of contemplation and dedication to our Lady. The Scapular Confraternity wears a special cloth to express dedication of self to Mary's service.
