July 6th,
St. Maria Goretti,
Virgin & Martyr

The early Church gloried in the young virgin martyr who preferred death over the loss of chastity. This was the story of Maria Goretti on July 6, 1902. Only twelve years of age, she was killed by fourteen knife wounds. The attack took place at Nettuno, near Rome, in the region of the Pontine Marshes. Pope Pius XII in 1950 canonized Maria Goretti a saint, with her aged mother in attendance.



July 11th,
St. Benedict,
Abbot

Today's saint has been truly a blessing—for his life and for his innumerable Benedictine sons and daughters. He founded a monastic tradition based on his "Monastic Rule." The Benedictine tradition has served both Church and civilization with distinction. Born in central Italy in 480, he studied at Rome before starting a hermit's life at Subiaco. Benedict founded the celebrated monastery at Cassino, and because of his Rule became the Patriarch of monasticism in Europe. He died on March 21, around 547.
