St. Romuald,
Abbot

Romuald, son of the Duke of Ravenna, was born in that illustrious city around the year 950. A follower of Benedict but called to the solitary hermit's life, he used to live as a hermit near Benedictine monasteries so as to join the monks in liturgical prayer. At Comaldi in the Appennine mountains he founded the Order of the Hermit Camaldolese monks. A follower of his could live as a monk, or as a hermit with liturgical prayer with monks, or as a complete solitary. In 1027 Romuald died in solitude.



June 21st,
St. Aloysius Gonzaga,
Religious

The son of a high dignitary of the Spanish court, Aloysius (born 1568) at age 16 gave up his hereditary right to be prince of Mantua in Italy. Called to a life of prayer and purity, he was attracted to the Jesuits. Their discipline made him advance remarkably in sanctity. Becoming ill from contagion while helping the sick, Aloysius died at age 23. Canonized a Saint in 1726, he was proclaimed "Patron of Youth" by Pope Benedict XIII.
