## Saints of the Week



March 17<sup>th</sup>,  
St. Patrick,  
Bishop

Patrick was the great apostle of Ireland. This small island has exported its people and Catholic faith throughout the world-to America and Australia-and has heavily influenced the history of the Church. Born around 385 in Great Britain, this child of a permanent deacon was kidnapped by Irish pirates. He later escaped, became a priest and returned to evangelize the pagan Irish. As Bishop, he organized well the Church in Ireland. He died around 461 in the "Island of Saints" which later came to know a thousand years of persecution.
