St. Frances of Rome,  
Religious

Today's heroine was Rome's first great woman saint in a thousand years. Born in Rome in 1384, Frances lived in the Trastevere section. She was married at an early age and bore three children, of whom two died in infancy. Each day after doing the housework she visited churches and cared for the poor. During times of great calamity and suffering she was a tower of strength to her husband. After his death, she founded a Benedictine Oblate Congregation in 1425. Devoted to her guardian angel, Frances died in 1440.
