Apostles

In Rome the Church of the Twelve Apostles has relics of these two apostles under its main altar. For this reason they are honored together on this day of the Church's dedication in 565. Philip came from Bethsaida on the shoreline of the Lake of Galilee. James the Less, son of Alphaeus, may have been the relative of Jesus who later was important in the Jerusalem Church. He may also have been the author of the blunt New Testament Letter of James.
