
The Rosary group will have a breakfast on Sunday, June 14, after both masses.

Saints of the Week



June 1st St. Justin, Martyr

"St. of Joy" – The delightful Philip

Neri gifted with a special sense of humor. Born in Florence in 1515. Philip came to Rome at age 26 and never left the Eternal City. Rome recently occupied and sacked (1527), was in pitiable condition, Philip visited the sick and imprisioned, taught the children, heard confessions. He founded the Oratorio of Divine Love -Oratorian Priests. Philip delighted in walking to the Seven Basicilicas in Rome. He died at 80, was canonized in 1622, and remains an influential force in Rome and throughout the Catholic world.



June 2nd. Sts. Marcellinus & Peter, Martyrs

These two martyrs are associated

with the catacombs-those vast underground burial chambers of special importance for the early centuries of our faith. The catacombs of Marcellinus and Peter, located outside Rome, contain the richest collection of early Christian paintings. A beautiful inscription from Pope Damasus states that Peter and Marcellinus demonstrated edifying serenity in the face of death. They were martyred around 304 or 305. The family of Constantine built a large basilica in their honor.
