In Brief:

96. What Christ entrusted to the apostles, they in turn handed on by their preaching and writing, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, to all generation, until Christ returns in glory.

97. "Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture make up a single sacred deposit of the Word of God" (DV 10), in which, as in a mirror, the pilgrim Church contemplates God, the source of all her riches.

98. "The Church, in her doctrine, life, and worship, perpetuates and transmits to every generation all that she herself is all that she believes" (DV 8 SS1).
