St. John of Capistrano,

Today's saint (1386-1456) had a remarkable life. Born in Capistrano (Abruzzi) Italy, he was a lawyer and judge. At age 30 he joined the Franciscans. Trained by St. Bernardine of Siena, John Capistrano preached effectively throughout Italy. Various Popes sent him to preach-in France, Germany, Austria, Poland. He reformed monasteries, opposed the Hussites, preached in Hungary against the Turks. John of Capistrano, worn out by superhuman efforts, died in Croatia, and was canonized a saint in 1690.
