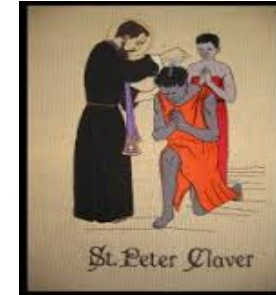
Parish News

This was a life of heroic dedication. Born in Spain, Peter Claver vowed to become a missionary in America. Ordained as a Jesuit in Colombia, he vowed to serve Negro slaves. Peter would meet the African slave ships at Cartagena and enter the infested hold to care for the dead, dying and sick. He instructed and baptized the slaves, helped them on the plantations, and brought 300,000 to Christ and the Church. Peter Claver, who called himself “the slaves of the negroes forever,” died September 8, 1654, and was canonized a saint in 1888.
