Catechism of the Catholic Church
I Believe in Jesus Christ, The Only Son of God

In Brief:

452. The name Jesus means "God Saves." The child born of the Virgin Mary is called Jesus, "for he will save his people from their sins" (Mt. 1:21): "there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 28:20).

453. The title "Christ" means "Anointed One" (Messiah). Jesus is the Christ, for "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power" (Acts 10:38). He was the one "who is to come" (Lk 7:19), the object of "the hope in Israel" (Acts 28:20).
