Catechism of the Catholic Church
I Believe in Jesus Christ, The Only Son of God

In Brief:

454. The title “Son of God” signifies the unique and eternal relationship of Jesus Christ to God his Father: he is the only son of the Father (cf. Jn 1:14, 18; 3:16,18); he is God himself (cf. Jn 1:1). To be a Christian, one must believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God (cf. Acts 8:37; 1Jn 2:23).

455. The title “Lord” indicates divine sovereignty. To confess or invoke Jesus as Lord is to believe in his divinity. “No one can say ‘Jesus is Lord’ except by the Holy Spirit” (1 Cor 12:3).
