Catechism of the Catholic Church

I Believe In The Holy Spirit

In Brief:

745. The Son of God was consecrated as Christ (Messiah) by the anointing of the Holy Spirit at his Incarnation (cf. Ps 2:6-7).

746. By his Death and Resurrection, Jesus is constituted in glory as Lord and Christ (cf. Acts 2:36). From his fullness, he poured out the Holy Spirit on the apostles and the Church.

747. The Holy Spirit, whom Christ the head pours out on his member, builds, animates, and sanctifies the Church. She is the sacrament of the Holy Trinity's communion with men.
