Catechism of the Catholic Church In The Image Of God

In Brief:

382. "Man, though made of body and soul, is a unity" (GS 14 &4). The doctrine of the faith affirms that the spiritual and immortal soul is created immediately by God.

383. "God did not create man a solitary being. From the beginning, male and female he created them (Gen 1:27). This partnership of man and woman constitutes the first form of communion between persons" (GS 12 &4).

284. Revelation makes known to us the state of original holiness and justice of man and woman before sin: from their friendship with God flowed the happiness of their existence in paradise.
