Catechism of the Catholic Church

“Conceived by the Power of the Holy Spirit and was born of the Virgin Mary”

In Brief:

510. Mary “remained a virgin in conceiving her Son, a virgin in giving birth to him, a virgin in carrying him, a virgin in nursing him at her breast, always a virgin” (St. Augustine, Sermon 186, 1: PL 38,999): with her whole being she is “the handmaid of the Lord” (Lk 1:38).

511. The Virgin Mary “cooperated through free faith and obedience in human salvation” (LG 56). She uttered her yes “in the name of all human nature” (St. Thomas Aquinas, STh III, 30,1). By her obedience she became the new Eve, mother of the living.
