Catechism of the Catholic Church

“Christ’s Faithful – Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life”

In Brief:

937. The Pope enjoys, by divine institution, “Supreme, full, immediate, and universal power in the care of souls” (CD2).

938. The Bishops, established by the Holy Spirit, succeed the apostles. They are “the visible source and foundation of unity in their own particular Churches” (LG23).

939. Helped by the priests, their co-workers, and by the deacons, the bishops have the duty of authentically teaching the faith, celebrating divine worship, above all the Eucharist, and guiding their Churches as true pastors. Their responsibility also includes concern for all the Churches, with and under the Pope.
