Feast of the Baptism of the Lord
January 12th



Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. This brings to an end the season of Christmas and the beginning of Ordinary time in the liturgical year.

In the baptism of the Lord, Jesus descended into the River Jordan to sanctify its waters and to give them the power to beget sons of God. "The event takes on the importance of a second creation in which the entire Trinity intervenes."

In the Eastern Church this feast is a Theophany because at the baptism of the Lord in the River Jordan God appeared in three persons. Jesus did not need the baptism of John, but as

Matthew tells it the purpose of Jesus Baptism is to fulfill God's saving plan. In Jesus Christ all prophecy is completed and a new age begins. In the baptism of Jesus we recognize the messiah so the longtime of waiting is ended.
