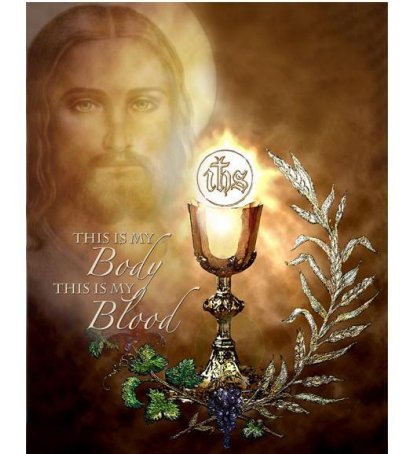


The Confirmation candidates will have a class on Wednesday, June 17th at 6:00 p.m. in the Heritage Room.
