**Parish Announcements**

**Dear Parishioners,**

We are very happy to begin having public masses. We need to be careful to follow the safety guidelines proposed by our Diocese and local officials.

**Here are some guidelines from the Bishop:**

- 1.-People over the age of 65 should be encouraged to continue participating from home.
- 2.-People with a heart condition or diabetes, or have other underlying at-risk conditions, should be encouraged to continue participating from home.
- 3.-Dispensation from Sunday obligation to attend in person is extended through May, especially with respect to people who may be considered physically well to attend, yet believe it best to stay at home.
- 4.-Weddings and Funerals are permitted, utilizing size consideration and social distancing protocols.

**Concerning the celebration of Sunday Mass, consider the following:**

- 1.-No more than 25% of the mandated fire code seating capacity of the church will be allowed in. No one will be allowed after the 25% capacity.
- 2.-Parishioners should take their temperatures before coming to Mass and should not attend if exhibiting any signs of sickness.
- 3.-All those in attendance at Mass must wear a mask and gloves throughout the Mass.
- 4.-Sanitize your hands before Mass.
- 5.-Only the main entrance will be use when entering the church.
- 6.-Ushers/greeters are to wear gloves and masks, and to open and close doors for parishioners upon their arrival and departure.
- 7.-Parishioners are to be seated in every other pew.
- 8.-Parishioners should not gather too closely when entering or leaving the church.
- 9.-The person receiving communion is encouraged to receive in the hand.
- 10.-Choir members should practice proper social distancing.
- 11.-Baskets will be at the entrance for offertory envelopes.
- 12.-To receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation call the office for an appointment.
- 13.-Those unable to attend the Mass and would like to receive the Eucharist should call the office and make an appointment.
