St. Patrick's Feast Day

Thursday, March 17



St. Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland and one of the most successful Christian missionaries in history. He is credited with expanding literacy in Ireland and converting the country to Christianity. He used the Shamrock to explain the Trinity to the people.

St. Patrick's Church

Bloomington, the town, was formally established in 1907. The first Mass was in a small home in 1915 and later in an old schoolhouse, a pool hall, and an old mortuary. In 1920 Sacred Heart Church came into existence and used the mortuary building until 1942 at which time it became a mission of Our Lady of Sorrows. In 1942 a new building was built and used until outgrown. On September 15, 1959, St. Patrick's Church became a new independent church.

Through the interest, concern, and generosity of Mr. & Mrs. Patrick Welder, funds were provided to build and donate St. Patrick's Church and rectory in memory of their parents, Mr & Mrs. Patrick Hughes Welder, Sr. The church was dedicated on May 1, 1960. **
