Fasting & Abstinence

- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.
- The law of **fasting** allows one full meal and two smaller ones. The obligation of fasting obliges all people between the ages of 18-59.
- The law of **abstinence** prohibits the eating of meat. The obligation of abstinence begins at age 14.
- The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

Rice Bowls

You are encourage to take one for your family and to participate by placing the money you saved into the bowl each time you fast or abstain during Lent. There is a pamphlet in each box with a calendar and suggestions for participation. The money will be sent to the Catholic Relief Service to feed people throughout the world.
