Dear Saint Patricks Parishioners,,

The Bloomington Board of Trustees has approved placing a bond on the May ballot. As superintendent of Bloomington ISD, I can neither advocate for or against the bond, but I can explain the purpose of the bond and explain how it should not affect your tax rate.

Bloomington ISD (the district) has a fund balance of approximately 1.5 million dollars in the I&S fund. These funds can only be used for bonds, they may not be used for any other activities or purchases. To access this money, the district must pass a bond. ***There is no anticipated tax increase, since this money is already part of the I&S fund balance.*** If the bond is passed, these funds will become available to the district and will be paid back within three years. ***Again, there is no anticipated tax increase for the community.***

The district will use the funds for the following improvements:

1. Campus Safety and Security: Our goal would be to upgrade our security systems, add fencing for more secure campuses, add vestibule doors for security and there will be other areas that the district will address.
2. Renovations to the AG/Welding Shop: Many of our students graduate from Bloomington and find careers in manufacturing and trades. The district would use the bond money to complete a full shop remodel, add machines (AG-CNC Plasma Machine, welding machines, planers, saws, etc.) and update all electrical systems.
3. Renovate the AG farm: Our Ag farm has not been updated for approximately fifteen years.
